Head coach Mike Mooney begins his 24th year at Geneseo in 2008. Following on their most successful season in school history in 2004 with a 17-5-2 record, their first ever SUNYAC title and a trip to the NCAA Division III Final Four, the Knights posted a record of 11-7-2 in 2007, with another trip to the SUNYAC Tournament. A native of Amherst, Mooney was named the SUNYAC Coach of the Year in 1989, 1997 and 2006. He was named the NSCAA Northeast Regional Coach of the Year in 2004.

Head coach Nate Wiley begins his third season in 2008 following his team's trip to the 2006 SUNYAC Conference Tournament Championship game. Wiley spent the 2005 season as an assistant coach at Geneseo after serving as the head men's coach at Chowan (NC) College for three seasons from 2002-04. A 1999 graduate of Geneseo, Wiley was a two-time National Soccer Coaches Association of America All-Northeast Region selection and a two-time All-SUNYAC defender. He played in five Empire State Games for the Western Open team, earning one silver and two bronze medals.
